# Strength Support System for At-Risk youth

Develop accessible community support networks that provides mentorship, mental health resources, and crisis intervention for young people affected by violence or instability. Every young person should have somewhere safe to turn.





### Promote Respect and Emotional Intelligence in Education

Integrate lessons on empathy, consent, communication, and conflict resolution into school curriculums. Teaching these life skills early helps prevent future violence and promotes mutual respect among peers.

#### Invest in safe community spaces and Activities

Fund and maintain safe public areas, youth centres, and creative programmes that encourage belonging, purpose and leadership. Empowered youth are less vulnerable to violence when they have access to supportive environment.



#### Built Trust between youth and Law Enforcement

Create regular youth-police forums and collaborative projects to foster, understanding and transparency. Officers should receive specialised training on youth engagement and cultural awareness to build positive community.

# Amplify youth voices in policy and media

Ensure young people are meaningful involved in shaping safety polices and awareness campaigns. Their experiences and insights should guide decisions, public messaging and advocacy on community issues.
